Biographical Note: Harlan Fiske Stone II is a renowned researcher, collector, and exhibitor of Swiss philately, as well as a distinguished writer and editor. He has held leadership positions in philatelic organizations including the American Helvetia Philatelic Society, the Philatelic Foundation, the Postal History Society, and the Smithsonian National Postal Museum's Council of Philatelists. He has received some of philately's highest honors for exhibiting, including the APS World Series of Philately Champion of Champions awards in both multi-frame and single-frame categories and several international gold medals. He has been a contributor to eleven periodicals based in Switzerland, Great Britain, and the United States, and served as the editor of the *Helvetia Alphorn* (1969-1974) and the *Postal History Journal* (1989-1999). Stone received the Alfred F. Lichtenstein Memorial Award from the Collectors Club in 2009, and in 2006 the American Philatelic Society gave him the John N. Luff award for distinguished philatelic research.

Abstract: This collection comprises Stone's personal research materials, accumulated over 45 years, on Swiss stamps and postal history.

Types of material: The collection is largely made up of clippings from various periodicals. It also contains handwritten notes, correspondence, edited manuscripts from *Helvetia: Society of Collectors of Switzerland*, photocopies of exhibits, exhibit notes, photographs, and negatives.
