Biographical Note: Thomas J. Alexander is a noted philatelic scholar as well as a distinguished author. He has held leadership positions in various philatelic organizations, including president of the U.S. Philatelic Classics Society from 1981-1984, Council of Philatelists of the Smithsonian National Postal Museum, and many committees of the American Philatelic Society. He served as the editor of the 1851 section of *The Chronicle* for over twenty years. His published books include: *1847 Cover Census*, *Simpson's Postal Markings: 1851-1861*, and *The Travers Papers: United States Postal History and Postage Stamps: Official Records*. His many philatelic awards and honors include the Alfred F. Lichtenstein Memorial Award (2007), the Luff Award for distinguished philatelic research (1985), and Smithsonian Philatelic Achievement Award (2004).

Abstract: This collection comprises Alexander's personal research materials on philately and history, mostly relating to Kansas, Missouri, and the mid-nineteenth century United States, as well as papers from Tracy Simpson, John Eggen, Wilson Hulme, and Creighton Hart.

Types of Material: The collection contains many different kinds of papers, as well as slides, microfiche, microfilm, photographs, and photograph negatives. The philatelic papers range from correspondence and biographical clippings to edited manuscripts, data on the 1847 cover census, exhibit and research notes, and general clippings.

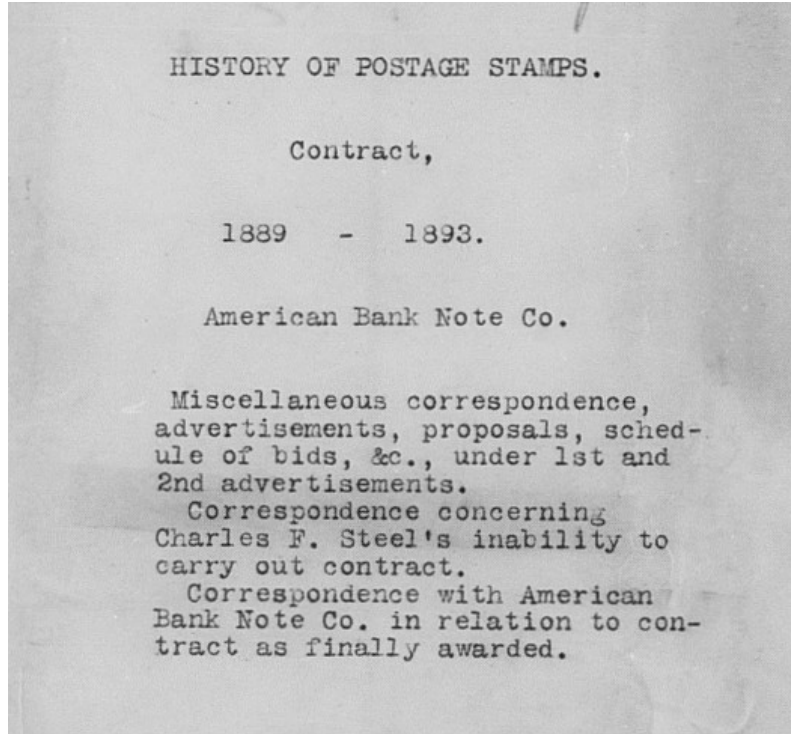
